HISAN was registered in Somalia under the Ministry of Education, Woman's Department in 1989. The Eastern Africa Regional Office registered in Kenya. 1994 to take care of Kenya and Somalia activities.

Mission

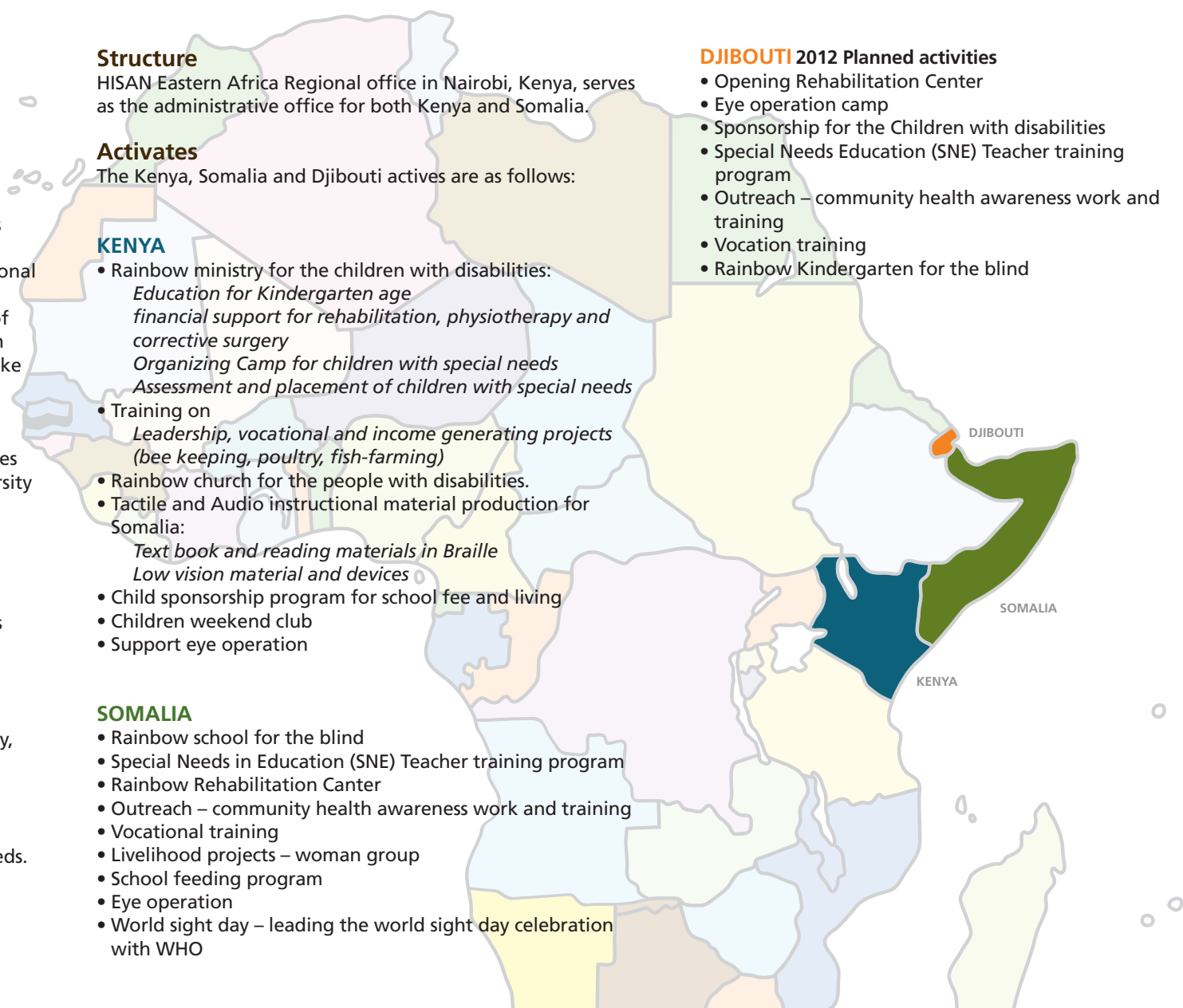
Goal

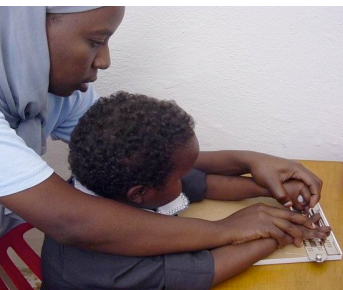
